

10 **INTERIM ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

11 Based on the foregoing stipulations and agreements, an Interim Order of Suspension is
12 hereby issued immediately suspending Respiratory Care Practitioner License No. 17789
13 heretofore issued by the Respiratory Care Board of California to respondent Stacy P. Crandall,
14 R.C.P., and, accordingly, respondent is hereby immediately prohibited from practicing respiratory
15 care in the State of California pending the issuance of a final Decision and Order by the
16 Respiratory Care Board on an Accusation to be filed against her before the Respiratory Care
17 Board of California. Any motion to vacate this Interim Order of Suspension shall be filed in
18 accordance with the provisions of Title 1, California Code of Regulations, sections 1006 and
19 1022. However, no such motion may be heard on an *ex parte* basis and any motion to vacate this
20 Interim Order of Suspension shall be served on complainant's counsel and filed with the Office of
21 Administrative Hearings no less than thirty (30) business days prior to any hearing on the motion.
22 Once served and filed, no such motion shall be decided without first affording the parties the
23 opportunity to present oral argument.
