22 California, by Catherine E. Santillan, Senior Legal Analyst.

23 2. Peter M. Callahan (Respondent) is represented in this proceeding by
24 attorney Stephen Wright, whose address is 123 Jewell Street, Santa Cruz, California 95060.

25 3. On or about September 6, 1995, the Respiratory Care Board of California
26 issued Respiratory Care Practitioner License No. 18069 to Respondent. The license was in full
27 force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 1H 2007 638 and
28 will expire on May 31, 2009, unless renewed.

1 CONTINGENCY

2 10. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Respiratory Care
3 Board. Respondent understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the
4 Respiratory Care Board of California may communicate directly with the Board regarding this
5 stipulation and surrender, without notice to or participation by Respondent or his counsel. By
6 signing the stipulation, Respondent understands and agrees that he may not withdraw his
7 agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation prior to the time the Board considers and acts upon
8 it. If the Board fails to adopt this stipulation as its Decision and Order, the Stipulated Surrender
9 and Disciplinary Order shall be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be
10 inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, and the Board shall not be disqualified from
11 further action by having considered this matter.

12 11. The parties understand and agree that facsimile copies of this Stipulated
13 Surrender of License and Order, including facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force
14 and effect as the originals.

15 12. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties
16 agree that the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the
17 following Order:

18 ORDER

19 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respiratory Care Practitioner License No. 18069,
20 issued to Respondent Peter M. Callahan, is surrendered and accepted by the Respiratory Care
21 Board.

22 13. The surrender of Respondent's Respiratory Care Practitioner License and
23 the acceptance of the surrendered license by the Board shall constitute the imposition of
24 discipline against Respondent. This stipulation constitutes a record of the discipline and shall
25 become a part of Respondent's license history with the Board.

26 14. Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as a respiratory care
27 practitioner in California as of the effective date of the Board's Decision and Order.
