IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the above-entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:

1. That the noticed hearing on the Petition for Interim Order of Suspension filed in the above-entitled matter is presently scheduled for June 10, 2008, at 10:00 a.m., at the Office of the Administrative Hearings located at 1350 Front Street, Room 6022, San Diego, CA. 92101.

1 2. That Respondent, Thomas Milton Bell, R.C.P., is represented in the
2 above-entitled matter by Ronald G. Skipper, Esq.

3 3. That Respondent Thomas Milton Bell, R.C.P., has been served with a true
4 and correct copy of the Petition for Interim Order of Suspension and all supporting declarations
5 and exhibits in the above-entitled matter.

6 4. That Respondent Thomas Milton Bell, R.C.P., is fully aware of his right to
7 a noticed hearing on the Petition for Interim Order of Suspension in the above-entitled matter, as
8 well as all other rights accorded him under California Business and Professions Code section 494
9 which include, at a minimum, the following rights:

10 (a) To have a record made of the proceedings, copies of which shall be
11 available to the licentiate upon payment of costs computed in accordance with the
12 provisions for transcript costs for judicial review contained in Section 11523 of
13 the Government Code.

14 (b) Present affidavits and other documentary evidence.

15 (c) To present oral argument.

16 Having the benefit of counsel, Respondent Thomas Milton Bell, R.C.P., hereby
17 knowingly, intelligently, freely and voluntarily waives and gives up each and every one of the
18 rights set forth and/or referenced above.

19 5. Having the benefit of counsel, Respondent Thomas Milton Bell, R.C.P.,
20 hereby knowingly, intelligently, freely and voluntarily stipulates that the statutory requirements
21 for issuance of an Interim Order of Suspension of his Respiratory Care Practitioner License No.
22 1915 have been satisfied in this case and, on that basis, hereby further stipulates to the issuance
23 of an Interim Order of Suspension of his Respiratory Care Practitioner License No. 1915
24 immediately prohibiting him from practicing as a Respiratory Care Practitioner in the State of
25 California pending further order from the Office of Administrative Hearings.

26 6. Having the benefit of counsel, Respondent Thomas Milton Bell, R.C.P.,
27 hereby knowingly, intelligently, freely and voluntarily waives his rights to a hearing on the
28 charges and allegations contained in Accusation No. 1H-2007-590 within thirty (30) days of

1 receipt by Deputy Attorney General David P. Chan of Respondent's Notice of Defense in Case
2 No. 1H-2007-590 and hereby stipulates to a later hearing.

3 7. The parties hereby stipulate that all proceedings in the above-entitled
4 matter shall be conducted at the Office of Administrative Hearings located in San Diego,
5 California.
