19 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties in this
20 proceeding that the following matters are true:

21 PARTIES

22 1. Stephanie Nunez (Complainant) is the Executive Officer of the Respiratory Care
23 Board of California. She brought this action solely in her official capacity and is represented in
24 this matter by Kamala D. Harris, Attorney General of the State of California, by Steve Diehl,
25 Deputy Attorney General.

26 2. Celedonio S. Blancaflor (Respondent) is representing himself in this proceeding and
27 has chosen not to exercise his right to be represented by counsel.

1 CULPABILITY

2 8. Respondent admits the truth of each and every charge and allegation in Accusation
3 and Petition to Revoke Probation No. D1 2011 561, agrees that cause exists for discipline and
4 hereby surrenders his Respiratory Care Practitioner License No. 21184 for the Board's formal
5 acceptance.

6 9. Respondent understands that by signing this stipulation he enables the Board to issue
7 an order accepting the surrender of his Respiratory Care Practitioner License without further
8 process.

9 PROVISIONS

10 10. This Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order is intended by the parties
11 herein to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final and exclusive embodiment of
12 the agreements of the parties in the above-entitled matter.

13 11. The parties agree that facsimile copies of this Stipulated Surrender of License and
14 Disciplinary Order, including facsimile signatures of the parties, may be used in lieu of original
15 documents and signatures and, further, that facsimile copies shall have the same force and effect
16 as originals.

17 12. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree the
18 Executive Officer of the Board may, without further notice to or opportunity to be heard by
19 Respondent, issue and enter the following Disciplinary Order on behalf of the Board:

20 ORDER

21 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respiratory Care Practitioner License No. 21184, issued to
22 Respondent Celedonio S. Blancaflor, is surrendered and accepted by the Board.

23 1. The surrender of Respondent's Respiratory Care Practitioner License and the
24 acceptance of the surrendered license by the Board shall constitute the imposition of discipline
25 against Respondent. This stipulation constitutes a record of the discipline and shall become a part
26 of Respondent's license history with the Board.

27 2. Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as a Respiratory Care Practitioner in
28 California as of the effective date of the Board's Decision and Order.
