

# DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS January 1, 2023 – March 31, 2023

### **ALLISON, WINIFRED - RCP 17915**

Committed negligence, unprofessional conduct, and falsified entries in patients medical records. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years probation effective January 6, 2023.

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#### DACAYO, LORI ELIZABETH – RCP 18126

Committed negligence, unprofessional conduct, and a pattern of substandard care in her care and treatment of a patient. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on two (2) years probation effective January 6, 2023. View Documents

# STENSETH, AARON PAUL CUSTODIO – RCP 36076

Unlawful use of a controlled substance and use of a controlled substance to an extent or in a manner dangerous to himself or others. Mental illness affecting competency while working as a respiratory care practitioner. Pursuant to a Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on four (4) years probation effective January 6, 2023.

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### **JOHNSON, VICTOR ELLIOT LINN - RCP 31234**

Prior revoked license based on violations of the terms and conditions of his probation. Pursuant to a Proposed Decision by an Administrative Law Judge, reinstatement of license granted, license immediately revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years probation effective March 1, 2023.

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#### MATA, SIMON C. - RCP 29344

Prior revoked license based on a conviction for driving under the influence of alcohol while on Board probation and violations of the terms and conditions of his probation. Pursuant to an order issued by the Board, reinstatement of license granted, license immediately revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years probation effective March 22, 2023.

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## EXPLANATION OF DISCIPLINARY LANGUAGE AND ACTIONS

**Effective date of decision:** The date the disciplinary decision goes into operation.

Default Decision: A decision based on the licensee's failure to respond to formal charges after it has been served, or failure to appear at an Administrative Hearing. All charges are deemed true. The decision results in the revocation of the license.

**Disciplinary Order:** An order for discipline adopted by the Board.

**Probation:** Allows the licensee to practice as a respiratory care practitioner under terms and conditions for a set amount of time.

Proposed Decision: A decision rendered by an Administrative Law Judge through an Administrative Hearing. A proposed decision must be adopted by the Board before it can go into effect.

Revoked: The right to practice is ended due to disciplinary action. The license is invalidated, voided, annulled, or rescinded. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

Revoked, Stayed: "Stayed" means the revocation is postponed. Professional practice may continue so long as the licensee complies with specified terms and conditions of probation.

**Stipulated Settlement:** A form of plea bargaining. The case is formally negotiated and settled prior to a hearing.

**Stipulated Surrendered:** The Board agrees to allow the licensee to surrender the license as a resolution to a disciplinary matter. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.
