

DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

July 1, 2018 – September 30, 2018

CUNNINGHAM, KIM MARIE – RCP 16251

Prior revoked license for providing negligent care and a conviction for driving under the influence. Pursuant to a Decision proposed by an Administrative Law Judge, petition for reinstatement of a revoked license granted, revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years' probation effective July 10, 2018.

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KIM, JANE YOUNG – RCP 25774

Ability to practice profession safely is impaired due to mental illness or physical illness affecting competency. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on one (1) year probation effective July 12, 2018.

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WILLIAMS, SARAH E – RCP 27965

Convicted of possession of methamphetamine on two separate occasions. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective July 25, 2018.

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PANERGO, CYREL – RCP 35423

Convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol with a prior conviction for driving under the influence of alcohol. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years' probation effective July 26, 2018.

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SHARMA, ROMEL RAHOOL – RCP 29812

Failed to comply with Board-ordered probation by failing to make daily contact with the Board-approved chemical testing laboratory and testing positive for Tramadol and alcohol. Pursuant to a Stipulated Surrender of License and Order, license surrendered effective August 6, 2018.

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SMITH, DAVID J – RCP 22501

Convicted of commercial burglary, petty theft on two separate occasions, and arrested for possession of a controlled substance and paraphernalia. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective August 8, 2018.

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EXPLANATION OF DISCIPLINARY LANGUAGE AND ACTIONS

Effective date of decision: The date the disciplinary decision goes into operation.

Default Decision: A decision based on the licensee's failure to respond to formal charges after it has been served, or failure to appear at an Administrative Hearing. All charges are deemed true. The decision results in the revocation of the license.

Disciplinary Order: An order for discipline adopted by the Board.

Probation: Allows the licensee to practice as a respiratory care practitioner under terms and conditions for a set amount of time.

Proposed Decision: A decision rendered by an Administrative Law Judge through an Administrative Hearing. A proposed decision must be adopted by the Board before it can go into effect.

Revoked: The right to practice is ended due to disciplinary action. The license is invalidated, voided, annulled, or rescinded. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

Revoked, Stayed: "Stayed" means the revocation is postponed. Professional practice may continue so long as the licensee complies with specified terms and conditions of probation.

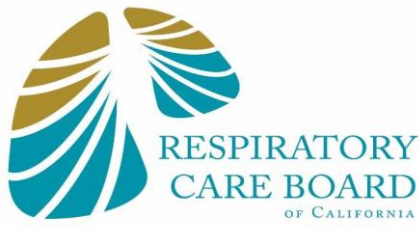
Stipulated Settlement: A form of plea bargaining. The case is formally negotiated and settled prior to a hearing.

Stipulated Surrendered: The Board agrees to allow the licensee to surrender the license as a resolution to a disciplinary matter. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

URUTIA, JOSHUA M – RCP 24422

Committed acts of negligence and unprofessional conduct by failing to treat a patient with Advair as prescribed by the treating physician and falsely charted in the record that he had treated with Advair. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective August 8, 2018.

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LOWE, JEFFERY DANIEL – RCP 15623

Committed acts of negligence and unprofessional conduct by failing to conduct a proper post-assessment after resecuring a patient's endotracheal tube, failing to notify the patient's health care providers at any time about the patient's severed pilot balloon, and making grossly incorrect entries in the patient's record. Pursuant to a Decision proposed by an Administrative Law Judge, license revoked effective August 14, 2018.

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ROJAS, JESUS M – RCP 28964

Failed to comply with Board-ordered probation by failing to abstain from mood altering substance and testing positive for alcohol on two separate occasions. Pursuant to a Decision proposed by an Administrative Law Judge, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years' probation effective August 28, 2018.

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CADAVONA, WENDY – RCP 20141

Worked in a health care environment while under the influence of amphetamine and methamphetamine. Pursuant to a Stipulated Surrendered of License and Order, license surrendered effective September 3, 2018.

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DER SARKISSIAN, GARINE – RCP 34791

Convicted of petty theft with a prior conviction for petty theft. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective September 5, 2018.

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GASANOV, RASHAD – RCP 24906

Committed an act of abuse towards a patient. Pursuant to a Decision proposed by an Administrative Law Judge, license revoked effective September 18, 2018.

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WELLS, JAMIE THERESE – RCP 35528

Convicted of second degree burglary of a vehicle and grand theft with prior convictions for disturbing the peace, driving under the influence of alcohol, and several arrests for public intoxication. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective September 19, 2018.

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JOHNSON, DONALD PAUL – RCP 27561

Committed acts of negligence and unprofessional conduct by failing to complete the administration of the medicated aerosol treatments, failing to assess patients immediately following the completion of their medicated aerosol treatments, failing to remain in the immediate vicinity of patients after initiating their medicated aerosol treatments, and initiating medicated aerosol treatment simultaneously. Falsified medical record entries by documenting post-treatment respiratory rates and pulse rates in the medical records of patients without completing their medicated aerosol treatments and failing to document in the medical records of patients that he did not complete their medicated aerosol treatments. Arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol. Pursuant to a Stipulated Surrendered of License and Order, license surrendered effective September 27, 2018.

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GUILIN, ALICE CECELIA – RCP 11406

Worked in a health care environment while under the influence of alcohol. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on four (4) years' probation effective September 27, 2018.

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
