

# DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

## July 1, 2021 – September 30, 2021

### DANIEL J. SANCHEZ – RCP 36233

Convicted of possession of a controlled substance, to wit, methamphetamine, stemming from two separate incidences. Previously convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol with a blood alcohol content of 0.08% or higher. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective July 1, 2021.

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### KIM, KENNETH LEE – RCP 36955

Failed to comply with Board-ordered probation by failing to abstain from use of mood-altering substances, used a controlled substance, to wit, cocaine. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective August 11, 2021.

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### VENABLE, DONCELLA MARIE – RCP 33681

Committed a negligent and unprofessional act by abandoning a patient during transport from the CT scan room to the intensive care unit. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license publicly reprimanded effective August 12, 2021.

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### ARSHAD, SADIA – RCP 34295

Convicted of driving under the influence of intoxicants in the State of Oregon. Previously convicted of driving under the influence of intoxicants. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license surrendered effective August 22, 2021.

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### TRINIDAD, DON CARLO M. – RCP 25143

Used a controlled substance in a manner dangerous or injurious to himself or others, to wit, methamphetamine, and drove while under the influence and/or drove recklessly. Previously revoked license for diversion of Fentanyl from patients on at least three occasions for his own personal use. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective September 1, 2021.

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### EXPLANATION OF DISCIPLINARY LANGUAGE AND ACTIONS

**Effective date of decision:** The date the disciplinary decision goes into operation.

**Default Decision:** A decision based on the licensee's failure to respond to formal charges after it has been served, or failure to appear at an Administrative Hearing. All charges are deemed true. The decision results in the revocation of the license.

**Disciplinary Order:** An order for discipline adopted by the Board.

**Probation:** Allows the licensee to practice as a respiratory care practitioner under terms and conditions for a set amount of time.

**Proposed Decision:** A decision rendered by an Administrative Law Judge through an Administrative Hearing. A proposed decision must be adopted by the Board before it can go into effect.

**Public Reprimand:** A lesser form of discipline that can be negotiated after or in lieu of the filing of formal charges. The reprimand may include educational and clinical training requirements.

**Revoked:** The right to practice is ended due to disciplinary action. The license is invalidated, voided, annulled, or rescinded. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

**Revoked, Stayed:** "Stayed" means the revocation is postponed. Professional practice may continue so long as the licensee complies with specified terms and conditions of probation.

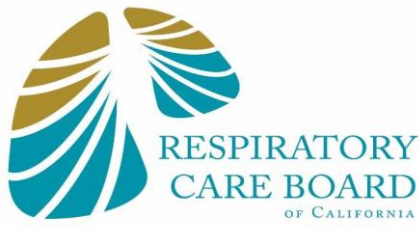
**Stipulated Settlement:** A form of plea bargaining. The case is formally negotiated and settled prior to a hearing.

**Surrendered:** The Board agrees to allow the licensee to surrender the license as a resolution to a disciplinary matter. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

### MENDOZA, GIOVANNY – RCP 30640

Convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol with a blood alcohol content of 0.20% or higher, convicted of resisting/obstructing an officer, and provided a false statement to the Board. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years probation effective September 20, 2021.

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## July 1, 2021 – September 30, 2021

### **O'REAR, APRIL – RCP 37994**

Convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol with a blood alcohol content of 0.08% or higher and admitted to the enhancement of excessive blood alcohol content of 0.20% or higher. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years probation effective September 20, 2021.

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
