BUTCHER, MICHAEL DAVID - RCP 19804

Placed on court ordered mental health diversion for a period of two (2) years after being criminally charged with assault with a deadly weapon and assault by means of force likely to produce great bodily injury. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on four (4) years probation effective July 3, 2022.

CURRAN, CHRISTOPHER - RCP 19263

Convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol with a blood alcohol content of 0.08% or higher and carrying a loaded firearm in a vehicle. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years probation effective July 7, 2022.

LITUCO, CECILIO G. - RCP 21925

Prior revoked license for failure to comply with Board-ordered probation including testing positive for methamphetamines, failing to make contact and report for testing, and failing to obey all laws; prior probationary status based on possession of a controlled substance and drug paraphernalia. Pursuant to a Proposed Decision by an Administrative Law Judge, reinstatement of license granted, license immediately revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years probation effective July 20, 2022.

DANIELS. TOYA LATRICE - RCP 28276

Prior revoked license based on convictions of welfare fraud in 2009 and 2012, followed by a prostitution-related conviction in 2014. Pursuant to a Proposed Decision by an Administrative Law Judge, reinstatement of license granted, license immediately revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years probation effective July 27, 2022.

EXPLANATION OF DISCIPLINARY LANGUAGE AND ACTIONS

Effective date of decision: The date the disciplinary decision goes into operation.

Default Decision: A decision based on the licensee's failure to respond to formal charges after it has been served, or failure to appear at an Administrative Hearing. All charges are deemed true. The decision results in the revocation of the license.

Disciplinary Order: An order for discipline adopted by the Board.

Probation: Allows the licensee to practice as a respiratory care practitioner under terms and conditions for a set amount of time.

Proposed Decision: A decision rendered by an Administrative Law Judge through an Administrative Hearing. A proposed decision must be adopted by the Board before it can go into effect.

Revoked: The right to practice is ended due to disciplinary action. The license is invalidated, voided, annulled, or rescinded. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

Revoked, Stayed: "Stayed" means the revocation is postponed. Professional practice may continue so long as the licensee complies with specified terms and conditions of probation.

Stipulated Settlement: A form of plea bargaining. The case is formally negotiated and settled prior to a hearing.

Stipulated Surrendered: The Board agrees to allow the licensee to surrender the license as a resolution to a disciplinary matter. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

HALFORD, TODD ELLIS – RCP 31247

Committed a crime involving sexual misconduct or attempted sexual misconduct, corrupt acts, unprofessional conduct, and violated or attempted to violate provisions of the Respiratory Care Practice Act when he attempted to engage in sexual acts with an individual he believed to be a minor. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective July 27, 2022.

CROSS, CHANTEZ MARIE - RCP 17400

Failed to comply with Board-ordered probation by failing to make contact and failing to report for testing, failing to pay costs, and failing to cooperate with the probation monitoring program. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective September 2, 2022.
