

DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

July 1, 2020 – September 30, 2020

AVALOS, YECENIA D. – RCP 36188

Convicted of willfully and lawfully disobeying a lawful court order and on another occasion, convicted of trespassing. Also, arrested for possession of drug paraphernalia and provided false statement on license renewal application. Previously convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol with a blood alcohol content of 0.08% or more. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective July 4, 2020.

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SANDFREY, ALAN JOSEPH – RCP 34082

Convicted of driving with a blood alcohol level of 0.08% or more. Previously cited and fined by the Board for a prior conviction for driving with a blood alcohol level of 0.08% or more. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years probation effective July 16, 2020.

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MCKINLEY, JEWEL JANET – RCP 25869

Convicted of making criminal threats. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective July 30, 2020.

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JOHNSON, DANIELLE ROSE – RCP 35736

Convicted of corporal injury resulting in traumatic condition upon a spouse or person in a dating relationship, assault with a deadly weapon, and child endangerment. Provided false statement on license renewal application. Pursuant to a Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order, license surrendered effective August 9, 2020.

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MURESAN, EMANUEL – RCP 23422

Convicted of battery and felony vandalism. Pursuant to a Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order, license surrendered effective August 9, 2020.

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EXPLANATION OF DISCIPLINARY LANGUAGE AND ACTIONS

Effective date of decision: The date the disciplinary decision goes into operation.

Default Decision: A decision based on the licensee's failure to respond to formal charges after it has been served, or failure to appear at an Administrative Hearing. All charges are deemed true. The decision results in the revocation of the license.

Disciplinary Order: An order for discipline adopted by the Board.

Probation: Allows the licensee to practice as a respiratory care practitioner under terms and conditions for a set amount of time.

Proposed Decision: A decision rendered by an Administrative Law Judge through an Administrative Hearing. A proposed decision must be adopted by the Board before it can go into effect.

Revoked: The right to practice is ended due to disciplinary action. The license is invalidated, voided, annulled, or rescinded. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

Revoked, Stayed: "Stayed" means the revocation is postponed. Professional practice may continue so long as the licensee complies with specified terms and conditions of probation.

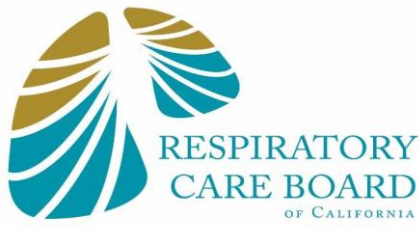
Stipulated Settlement: A form of plea bargaining. The case is formally negotiated and settled prior to a hearing.

Stipulated Surrendered: The Board agrees to allow the licensee to surrender the license as a resolution to a disciplinary matter. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

PYORALA, JUSTIN BRANDON – RCP 41226

Convicted of inflicting corporal injury to a current or former spouse, cohabitant, or child's parent. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on four (4) years probation effective August 13, 2020.

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DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

July 1, 2020 – September 30, 2020

PARKS, CARRIE JO – RCP 12787

Convicted of petty theft and driving under the influence of alcohol. Disobeyed a court order. Provided false statement on license renewal application. Previously cited and fined by the Board for a prior driving under the influence conviction and warned for a conviction for driving a motor vehicle with one's driving privilege suspended. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective September 2, 2020.

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NUNO, SUZANNA – RCP 24922

Convicted of child endangerment. Provided false statement on license renewal application. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on four (4) years probation effective September 3, 2020.

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SANVICENTE, JORDAN KYLE – RCP 36332

Failed to comply with Board-ordered probation by failing to comply with the biological fluid testing program, respond to probation monitor, and pay probation monitoring fees and cost recovery. Pursuant to a Stipulated Surrender of License and Order, License surrendered, effective September 27, 2020.

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
