



## COMPLAINT DISCLOSURE POLICY

It is the policy of the Respiratory Care Board of California (Board) to disclose complaint information concerning a licensee or applicant only after a formal charge is filed by the Office of the Attorney General.

Information that will be disclosed includes:

- The type of action (i.e. Accusation or Statement of Issues) and the information disclosed in the pleading.
- The status of the action if a formal decision has not been rendered.
- The final decision and any discipline imposed.
- Any information the RCB has as to whether the District Attorney/City Attorney has the case for review or has filed criminal charges and any criminal penalties imposed.

The Board will also advise that copies of any pleadings filed by the Office of the Attorney General on behalf of the Board are available upon request.
